

KNOWLEDGE QUEST SCHOLARSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

Knowledge Quest scholarships are intended to encourage and support college or university education for Bermudians of limited financial means. The central purpose of the scholarship is to foster higher learning in the hopes that greater knowledge and education will contribute positively to Bermuda's future.

Terms & Conditions

All completed applications should be received no later than 15 May 2020.

Conditions under which the scholarships are awarded:

1. The scholarships are awarded annually. Their purpose is to provide financial support over a period of up to four years to students who are pursuing studies on a full-time basis at a college or university outside Bermuda. The scholarship is tenable at institutions of higher education approved by Knowledge Quest Scholarship Committee.
2. The scholarship funds are to be used to contribute to the costs of tuition, and room and board, at the place of study and will be paid directly to the university of the successful applicant.
3. The scholarship award(s) will be made by a scholarship committee. The applicant must have previously applied to at least five other local scholarships in order to be eligible for a Knowledge Quest Scholarship. The success or failure of these other scholarship applications must be reported to Knowledge Quest immediately upon notification of recipient.
4. The scholarship committee will pay special regard to:
 - a. scholastic ability and achievement;
 - b. financial need;
 - c. qualities of character, leadership, devotion to duty, and fellowship; and
 - d. athletic, cultural, or other non-academic pursuits.
5. To be eligible for the Knowledge Quest Scholarship, the candidate must
 - a. hold Bermuda status;
 - b. be able to identify specific educational or professional goals;
 - c. be willing, on completion of studies, to return to Bermuda and render service to the community.
6. The scholarship committee may decline to award any scholarships should it decide, in its sole discretion, that there are no suitable candidates.
7. The applicants chosen to receive a scholarship shall keep the scholarship committee informed of their progress by timely submission of grades or transcripts, a semi-annual report regarding academic progress and any matters that would affect the scholars' well-being or success, and such other reports as may be requested from time to time. Failure to comply may lead to suspension or forfeiture of the scholarship.

8. The scholarship committee reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship if the scholar becomes involved in any activity which, in its opinion, places the prestige of the scholarship in jeopardy. The committee may withdraw the scholarship if the scholar fails to achieve at least a C average or its equivalent.
9. The scholar is requested to complete at least one course in economics and another in government or political science.
10. The applicant accepting the Knowledge Quest Scholarship will be required to inform the scholarship committee of any other scholarships that he/she has applied for, or accepted. As soon as the applicant or current KQ scholar receives notice of an award of a scholarship, he/she must inform KQ at the following email address: info@knowledgequest.bm. Not doing so is grounds to rescind the KQ scholarship.
11. Applications should be submitted via www.bermudascholarships.com no later than 15 May 2020.

NOTE: Applications will not be processed unless all the prescribed documents are submitted. Applicants for the awards must be prepared to appear for an interview, if required by the scholarship committee, in the summer. Failure to do so will be taken as a withdrawal from the scholarship process.
